

**Strategic Intention:**

**Academic excellence**

*Historically, Tutshill School pupils have attained good academic results at the end of Key Stage 2 (KS2), exceeding the national expectations. This attainment could have been higher however, had the School enabled pupils to make consistent progress in their learning, thus adding greater value to their education*

*For all children to make at least expected progress with the opportunities for children to excel and make better than expected progress.*

**Strategic Goals:**

- ◆ to teach through whole school cross-curricular themes providing appropriate, stimulating resources and extending beyond the classroom
- ◆ to ensure that the curriculum is broad, rich, balanced and fit for purpose – a curriculum for the future
- ◆ Continue to develop appropriate methods of monitoring teaching and learning to ensure high levels of attainment and achievement are being maintained
- ◆ Continue to develop staff knowledge and expertise across the curriculum
- ◆ Continue to review and develop relevant policies and planning strategies for the teaching of the school's curriculum
- ◆ Children achieve to the best of their ability and are monitored through regular assessments and tracking

The above will be achieved through:

- Embedding the new National Curriculum
- Developing a two year rolling curriculum
- Embed new assessment procedures
- Develop the use of learnpads in the children's learning



**Strategic Intention:** Spiritual development
