In our data handling work, we will be learning about Venn and Carroll diagrams and we will also be drawing our own bar graphs and pictograms.

What could you do at home? Why not go outside and measure the height of different plants in your garden? You could sort objects found in your house using Venn and Carroll diagrams.




Geography/History:

Topic This term, we will be recapping human and physical features of a location. We will then be focusing on the physical features, considering the physical features found in Tutshill. We will also be thinking about different types of plants and where they are found. Why do different types of plants grow in different places?



What could you do at home? Whilst out on your walk or bike ride, have a look at the different plants you can find. Can you also spot some physical features?

Science- This term will be all about plants and animals! We will be learning about different types of habitats and how these meet the needs of the creatures that live in them. We will be learning about food chains and how they occur. We will also be finding out about animals and their senses. Whilst learning about plants, we will be thinking about what they need to grow and develop. We will also be learning about the life cycle of a plant.

What could you do at home? Get growing! You could take photographs of plants on your walk and find out what they are called.

You might like to plant some beans, seeds or bulbs in different circumstances at home and see which survive the best!

English: This term, we will be working hard to improve our fabulous story and non-fiction writing by thinking about paragraphs and punctuation. We will be thinking carefully about how to improve our writing using adjectives and expanded noun phrases, different types of sentences and by writing longer pieces of work. We will be looking at non-fiction texts linked to plants and animals and writing our own non-fiction texts to explain or instruct. We will write poetry all about plants thinking about our use of descriptive vocabulary. This term, we will also continue to develop our reading and comprehension skills, really starting to think about what the author was trying to do when they wrote the texts we explore. We will continue to develop our cursive handwriting style and start to use it more and more in all of our writing. *What could you do at home? Read lots of different types of books and create a reading diary. Make your own fact book about minibeasts or plants.*

Computing- We will be thinking carefully about how to stay safe online. We will also be recapping how to change the style of font, font size and colour whilst creating our own posters and advertisements!
