Maths

In Maths this term, we will be having a big focus on problem-solving, linking it to all of the areas of Maths we have covered. We will be adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing decimal and whole numbers using mental and written methods. We will be classifying numbers in different ways and thinking carefully about decimals, fractions and percentages. Later in the term we will be collecting data linked to our topic and presenting it in different ways. As well as this, we will be investigating different types of angles and 3D shapes. To continue to build our confidence and proficiency, will be working on our arithmetic skills every day.

English

This term our English work will be based on our topic 'Walk on the Wild Side' which is all about the wonderful world around us! We will be producing a range of creative writing based on the text 'Fox', as well as writing our own poetry based on poems we have read such as 'Blake's Tyger' and 'To a Fur Scarf'.



Science

Our topic 'Walk on the Wild Side' is all about ourselves, the world around us and the animals we share it with. We will be using our investigative skills to find out about how all living things are categorised in our 'Living Things and their Habitats' unit. We will also be investigating 'Animals Including Humans' and looking carefully at our bodies and our health. We will be carrying out lots of pattern-seeking investigations to really encourage the children to think scientifically!

Art/ Design Technology
In Art, we will be thinking carefully about
different drawing techniques- drawing plants
using different materials both in black and white
and in colour. We will also be studying the work
of Henri Rousseau and creating pieces of art
based on impressions of animals and plants.

In Design and Technology, we will be using our designing, making and evaluating our own 3D models of animals with moving parts!

PE

In PE this term, the children will be learning valuable skills for all aspects of PE, including Athletics. They will also be improving their catching, throwing and hitting skills in field games like rounders and kwik cricket.

Our Topic is Science-based this term and so we will be investigating the world we live in and all of the fantastic animals and plants that we share it with!

Computing

We will be using the iPads to carry out research on the Internet, finding out exciting information about the habitats of different animals. We will use this research to create databases and spreadsheets.

We will also be improving our Coding skills using a range of programs.

We will be also be learning...

RE: In RE we will be looking at the question 'What would Jesus do?'. We will be making connections between Gospel texts, Jesus' 'good news' and how Christians and examining our own faith and beliefs.

PSHE: In our topic 'Being my Best' we will focus on our aspirations for ourselves now and in the future. We will think about goals we have for ourselves and how Growth Mindset and positivity can help us to achieve them.

French: In French we will be revising French vocabulary linked to occupations, animals, numbers, preferences, everyday objects and family members.

Music

In Music lessons, the children will be performing together-investigating songs which help them to look back to celebrate happy memories and also look forward to the next stages in their lives. The children will be exploring musical processes used to create compositions, thinking carefully about beat, tempo and pitch.
