Dear Parent and Carers,

As you are aware, we have at times been operating with minimal staff, yet are very pleased that we did not have to make any class closures, not all schools have been so lucky! I would like to say a personal 'thank you' to all the staff at the School for enabling this to happen; class swaps, additional lunch cover, delivering lunches and so much more! Without the dedication and hard work of the staff we couldn't have stayed open- thank you!

It was a pleasure to have had so many parents come on site for Parental Consultations. I do hope that the hybrid approach worked, we will be asking for parental feedback to see if this approach, with tweaks, is something we operate again in the future.

As you may be aware, government guidance changed on 1 April 2022. After Easter, the School will be adhering to the following guidance:

- Should children have a fever, temperature or are genuinely unwell, we ask they stay at home, until they feel better and the temperature has returned to normal.
- Should children test positive, they are asked to stay away from people and school for 3 days.
- Staff testing positive will be required to stay away from people and work for 5 days.
- There is no requirement to test to return to school.

We are currently experiencing high rates of covid in the staff and pupil body and hope that the Easter break will act as a fire-break for us all! Thank you all for being so understanding during this challenging period.

The School is closed to pupil's tomorrow but the staff will be attending a curriculum development day on site. I wish you all a restful Easter break and very much look forward for all the excitement of the summer term!

School Admission for Ukrainian Families

We have finally received guidance from the DfE but are yet are to receive anything from Gloucestershire. A recent DfE circular states... '...all school-aged children and young people who arrive from Ukraine will have the right to access suitable education and childcare whilst in the UK.'

'The Secretary of State for Education has reminded local authorities, that they are able to use flexibilities to admit above the published admission number and exceed the infant class size limit, ... to ensure all school-aged children can access suitable education.'

It would therefore appear that families are expected to use the schools admissions processes to apply for a place in year at a school. Please follow this link to the school website
