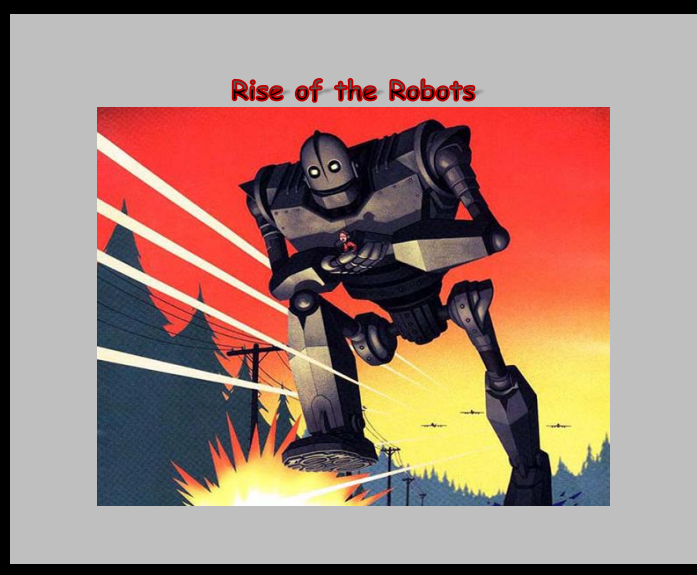
Computing
